

STATEMENT OF PUBLICATION ETHICS AND MALPRACTICE

AUTHORS are forbidden to present inaccurate, slanderous, and plagiarized statements. Works containing such information will be automatically rejected. Authors are advised not to submit their works to multiple publishers at the same time.

EDITORS are required to assess works only based on academic value; thus, they must not favor any author whatsoever. Editors are also forbidden to use any information presented in the papers they assess with view to publication.

REVIEWERS must evaluate all papers exclusively in relation with their scientific quality and will treat works submitted to them for evaluation as confidential documents. Reviewers will not assess papers which do not belong to their fields of professional expertise.

Both EDITORS and REVIEWERS will make sure that they evaluate each academic contribution within a set period of time. Failure to do so results in the author's right to withdraw the manuscript from publication with *Caesura*.

The Editorial Board
